

Extension Manager

Overview

A Hub administrator can manage extensions (i.e.: plugins, components, modules, templates, etc.), from the /administrator interface. Extensions are categorized into two sections - "Hubzero Core" and "Custom Extensions". Hubzero Core extensions are the core codeset of Hubzero and may be disabled for enabled but never completely removed. Hubzero Core extensions, however can be overridden by a Custom Extension of the same name. See the Web Developer documentation section for instructions on how to create your own.

Enabling Hubzero Core Extensions

1. Navigate to **/administrator**.
2. Hover over **Extensions** and select **Extension Manager**.
3. Click **Hubzero Core** to view the list of extensions.
4. **Check the box** beside the extension that you would like to enable.
5. Click the **Enable** button in the upper right corner.

Disabling Hubzero Core Extensions

1. Navigate to **/administrator**.
2. Hover over **Extensions** and select **Extension Manager**.
3. Click **Hubzero Core** to view the list of extensions.
4. **Check the box** beside the extension that you would like to disable.
5. Click the **Disable** button in the upper right corner.

Adding Custom Extensions

1. Navigate to **/administrator**.
2. Hover over **Extensions** and select **Extension Manager**.
3. Click **Custom Extensions** to view the list of extensions if available.
4. Click the **New** button in the upper right corner.
5. Complete the form.
6. Click the **Save & Close** button in the upper right corner.

Editing Custom Extensions

1. Navigate to **/administrator**.
2. Hover over **Extensions** and select **Extension Manager**.
3. Click **Custom Extensions** to view the list of extensions.
4. **Check the box** beside the extension that you would like to disable.
5. Click the **Edit** button in the upper right corner.
6. Complete the form.
7. Click the **Save & Close** button in the upper right corner.

Enabling Custom Extensions

1. Navigate to **/administrator**.
2. Hover over **Extensions** and select **Extension Manager**.
3. Click **Custom Extensions** to view the list of extensions.
4. **Check the box** beside the extension that you would like to enable.
5. Click the **Enable** button in the upper right corner.

Disabling Custom Core Extensions

1. Navigate to **/administrator**.
 2. Hover over **Extensions** and select **Extension Manager**.
 3. Click **Custom Extensions** to view the list of extensions.
 4. **Check the box** beside the extension that you would like to disable.
 5. Click the **Disable** button in the upper right corner.
