

 - » Client and/or server

- » Metadata catalog
- » Rules engine
- » https://irods.org/

{where are we today?}

※ Client

- » Command line utility
 - Identify
 - Publish
 - Describe
 - Query

* Server

- » RESTful API
- » Web based explorer

{where are we going tomorrow?}

- * Security
 - » Authenticity of metadata publisher
- * Automatic provenance generation
 - » Not just metadata, but data provenance
- * Automatic hub integration
 - » Publication triggers
- * Multi-institutional horizontal distribution
 - » Preferred server with DNS-style hierarchy
- * Metadata discovery
 - » Searching arbitrary metadata in a structured manner
