Configuring and Managing Your Hub: Content Customization - Activity Solutions

Step 1: Create a new section and category

- 1. Log in to the administrative interface (*myhub.org*/**administrator**)
- 2. Navigate to "Content -> Section Manager" and create a new section by clicking "New"
- 3. Navigate to "Content -> Category Manager" and create a new category by clicking "New"
 - a. Make sure that you assign the correct section to this category (i.e. the section created in the previous step)

Step 2: Create two or three test articles and assign them to that newly created section and category

- 1. Navigate to "Content -> Article Manager" and create three new articles by clicking "New"
 - a. Each of these articles should be assigned the section and category that you just previously created

Step 3: Create a new menu and menu items for those articles

- 1. Navigate to "Menus -> Menu Manager" and select "New"
- 2. Give your new menu a unique name and title, then click "Save"
- 3. Now you will see your new menu in the list. Click the icon next to that list to add menu items
- 4. Now click the "New" button to add new menu items to your menu
- 5. After clicking "New", select "Article Layout"
- 6. Next, fill in the necessary information
 - a. After creating this menu item, you'll be able to access this article page via the Alias of the menu item
- 7. Click "Save" in the upper right-hand corner
- 8. At this point, simply repeat the previous steps to create menu items for all of the articles that you want to use together

Step 4: Create a new menu module and position it on those article pages

- 9. To do this, navigate to "Extensions -> Module Manager"
- 10. Next, select "New"
- 11. Scroll down and select "Menu" from the list
- 12. Now fill in the correct information...make sure to:
 - a. Give it a "Title"
 - b. Be sure "Enabled" is "yes"
 - c. Give it the position "Left"
 - d. Set it to display on the correct pages
 - i. Under menu assignment, "control click" the menu items that we made in the preceding steps. This is what tells *Joomla!* which pages to display the new menu on.
 - e. Under "Module Parameters", "Menu Name" should be the title of the menu that we created earlier

- f. "Menu Style" should be list
- 13. When all of this has been done, click "Save"
